## **Picture Library Fees & Conditions**

*The Brontë Parsonage Museum holds a large archive of manuscripts, drawings and photographs related to the Brontës. Providing photographs enables us to make the collection available to a wider audience and, as a Registered Charity, income from the Picture Library provides a valuable source of funding.*

### **What is Available?**

A range of images is available for private study or reproduction. These include selected manuscripts, letters and drawings, portraits of the Brontë family\* and people known to them, objects from the Museum Collection, and interior and exterior views of the Parsonage.

### **Photographs for Private Study**

Photographs for private study are provided on the understanding that they will not be reproduced without prior written permission of the Brontë Society.

### **Photographs for Reproduction**

Photographs provided for reproduction are subject to a number of conditions which are listed in this leaflet.

### **Availability of Service**

The Picture Library is run from the Brontë Parsonage Museum Research Library. Enquiries by telephone 9.00am – 5.00pm Monday – Friday.

### **Enquiries**

Initially, enquiries concerning photographs should be addressed to the Library Staff, who run the Picture Library. We will advise you on the availability of images and their suitability for your needs.

### **Payment of Fees**

Our accounts department will email an invoice to you and include details on how to make a payment. Please arrange to make your payment in Sterling and contact our accounts department if you are in any doubt as to how to pay.

Reproduction Fees are payable on first publication and again on any subsequent publication of the images in further editions, or in any related or unrelated works in any medium.
